

Inclement Weather Policy

Updated March 2023

If inclement weather could potentially make travel conditions to and from the church building dangerous for the Restoration Alliance Church (the "Church") community, the elders shall determine whether to cancel services or activities.

The following guidelines will be used to determine if we will cancel, or delay events/services:

Level 1 Snow Emergency – We will open at our normal time and all activities will go on as planned. Please give ample time to safely make your way to the church building.

Level 2 Snow Emergency – Any activity scheduled *at or before 10 AM* will be canceled. This means on Sundays, Adult Bible Study at 9 AM would be canceled. The elders will then decide whether to have service 2.5 hours before the service time (8 AM for a 10:30 AM service time). The Sunday morning worship rehearsal would then be moved to 9 AM, instead of at 8 AM. *In the event of a special service, a determination will also be made 2.5 hours before the event (for a 7 PM service, by 4:30 PM; for a 4 PM service, by 1:30 PM).*

The church will be informed of cancelations via multiple ways:

- 1. An all-church email will be sent out
- 2. An all-church text will be sent out
- 3. The church center app will send out a notification
- 4. The church Facebook page will be updated to reflect the cancelation
- 5. The church's webpage will be updated with the cancelation

Level 3 Snow Emergency – all church activities will be canceled while Seneca County is under a Level 3 snow emergency.
